I'd just like to commend Herrmann-Pillath's review. Not only does it appear well informed, it is also even-handed and constructive. It seriously attempts to understand and respond to the arguments Garrett is offering. This should allow for some reworking that could lead to an improved contribution and, I believe, a valuable addition to the literature.

In contrast, the previous two reviewers of Garrett's manuscript clearly approach the process with a set of deeply held (economic) beliefs that prevent them from either seeing the strengths in the work, or offering constructive resolutions to the weaknesses. I appreciate that it is valid to believe that a manuscript has no merit, but this position has to be argued for having fully digested the arguments being presented in the manuscript.
