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Dear reviewer, Thank you very much for your thoughtful and constructive feedback. In line with your remark at point 13, we do believe that this article should keep its focus on methodological consideration while the results of the three case studies (not only the Rainfall ones) are already published elsewhere. We also believe that the paper bring a useful avenue for discussion and future research. Moreover, the whole underlining idea of household profiles proposed in the paper aims at overcoming the inherent tension between much needed site-specific research digging deeply into a situated reality (with a combination of quantitative methods and ethnographic and PRA

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methods, as presently represented in the literature) and generalizations conducive to comparability and general lessons for policy makers. This is explained in details in section 5.

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
