

Interactive comment on “Are there multiple scaling regimes in Holocene temperature records?” by T. Nilsen et al.

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Shaun Lovejoy’s report is not a conventional review of our discussion paper, but rather an essay which is a critique of our paper, but also a review and defence of his own work. A point-to-point response is almost impossible, and we feel confident that this is not the kind of discussion that the reviewer wants. We will therefore address his comments by following the logical structure of the review. Our response is attached as a supplement, and contains a number of new analyses and figures. Some of the text and figures may be incorporated in the revised paper and Supplementary Material. Substantial revision of our paper will follow as a result of both reviews, but an outline of this revision will not appear in this response, but at the end of the response to reviewer #2
