In this appendix we present evidences of lagged influences of the high northern latitude (HNL) climate [Arctic and northern forests temperature (TA, TNF)] over the Northern Hemisphere Temperature (NHT or T). Specifically, we present: a) reconstructed, simulated and observed records, b) evidences of T lags TA temperatures by multidecadal scales, b) evidences of T lags TNF by multidecadal scales, and c) an intercomparison of their consequent forecasts and a comparison with adjusted and extrapolated climate scenarios considering “zero emissions of CO<sub>2</sub>.”
